Job Description - MRC Trophies

Summary

- Prepare trophies, medals and salvers for the three competitions each year: Short Course Nationals, Nationals, Hasler Finals
- Arrange for trophies, medals and salvers to be delivered to each competition, and accounted for
- Arrange for trophies to be engraved after each competition
- Complete trophy and medal administration: re-ordering medals and boxes, arranging payment of invoices, updating Racing Handbook
- Store trophies and medals/boxes between competitions

Before Each Competition

About one month before:

- Check race entry classes
- Order Gold, Silver and Bronze plates for each class to go in medal boxes
- Order winning club salvers

About one week before:

- Clean trophies
- Put medals & medal plates in boxes (or leave hosting club to do this with sufficient time)
- Deliver trophies and medals to hosting club

At the Competition

- Oversee display and presentation of medals and trophies, or arrange for this to be done
- Ensure all trophies are returned after presentation (except short course) and collect unused medals and boxes

After the Competition

Arrange for trophies to be engraved and any damaged ones to be repaired

At Year End (after Hasler Finals)

- Carry out stocktake of medals and boxes for MRC Treasurer
- Order more medals and boxes if required (there are sufficient Nationals medals for 2024 but may need to order more Hasler medals)
- Submit trophy winners' names for Racing Handbook

Storage (most trophies are in plastic crates (70 x 45 x 30 cm), other trophies are in bespoke wooden boxes). Trophies are stored in:
